The parish of St. Paul the Apostle is proud to offer the Emily Elizabeth Hendryx Memorial Scholarship. This scholarship is given in loving memory of a young woman who personified what it truly means to be a disciple of Christ. The teaching of Christ, that we are all called “to serve and not to be served” is truly found in the life of Emily Hendryx, who faithfully served her family, friends, country and her Church.

Requirements

In keeping with Emily’s personality and great love for the Church, the scholarship is awarded annually to the student who most exemplifies the role of disciple of Jesus Christ: one who serves others with dignity and respect, one who lifts up the hearts and minds of others with love and affection, one who advocates Catholic ideals by being a role model to their peers, and one who truly lives their faith by trusting in God’s personal call to holiness.

The most important factor in granting this scholarship is not academic excellence, but the example of living out his/her Catholic ideals, providing a role model for his/her peers and fellow students and in service to the parish of St. Paul.

Any senior in High School planning to attend college, or young adult presently attending college, a registered member of St. Paul Catholic Church, is eligible to apply for the scholarship.

Application Process

Applications may be picked up from the St. Paul Parish Office or you may call to have an application mailed to you. The deadline for return of the application is July 8, 2018. The recipient will be announced and the award given at the 10:00 am Mass the date will be announced.

Selection Committee

All applications returned by July 8 will be reviewed and the recipient of the scholarship will be selected by the Pastor and the selection committee.
