IMPORTANT COVID 19 INFORMATION FOR OUR PARISH

Dear St. Paul the Apostle Community,

The days of no church are coming to an end this weekend, praise God. It is very important for you to know the following information as we start to gather again as the Body of Christ to worship and praise God.

First, we are only able to seat approximately 150 persons in the church proper. The Parish Hall has been staged with additional seating while viewing the Mass project into the Hall. Holy Communion will be brought into the Hall after it is distributed in the Church proper. Additionally, the gym has been arranged so that there will be an additional Mass at 4:00 on Saturdays, with seating for 108 people.

Our Mass schedule for the foreseeable future will be as follows:

Confessions 3:00 to 3:30 pm

Saturdays: 4:00 pm in the Church and the Gym simultaneously.

Sundays: 7:00 am, 10:00 am,

Spanish at 12:00 pm & 6:00 pm

(Note: The 4:00 pm in the gym and 6:00 pm on Sunday have been canceled.)

As you enter these various worship spaces, please following signage directions at all times. We have to do our very best with social distance protocols for the safety of us all. PLEASE bring your mask and wear it all during the liturgy, only to remove it to receive Communion which will be given in the hand per Bishops David P Talley's request

Last, a reminder to us all: Bishop Talley's dispensation for attending Mass is still active until June 30th. Please do not come to the church if you are not feeling well or if you are at risk do to other health concerns.

I am very much looking forward to seeing your faces, I have missed everyone.
